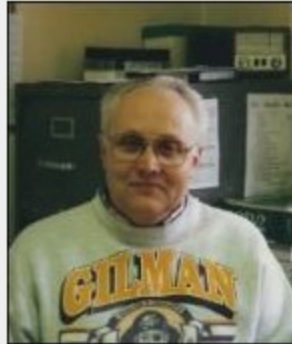


John Lee Agen
