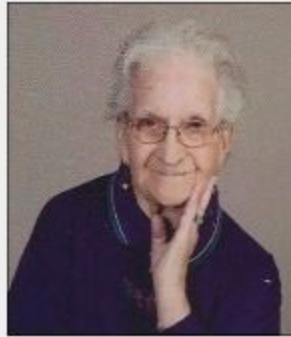


Margaret Hartzell
