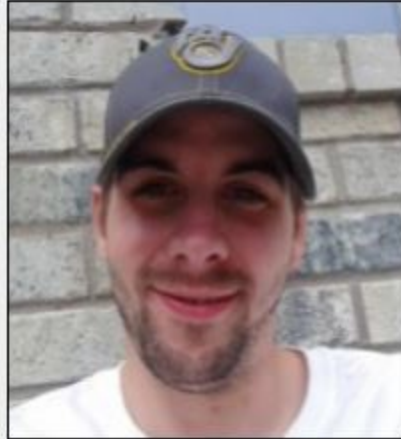


Kevin Alexander Krizan
