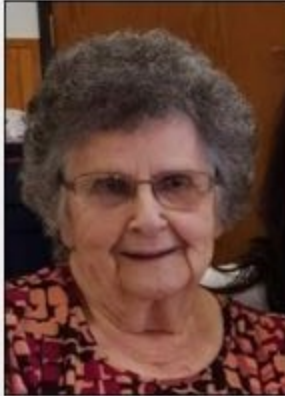


Florence Milas
