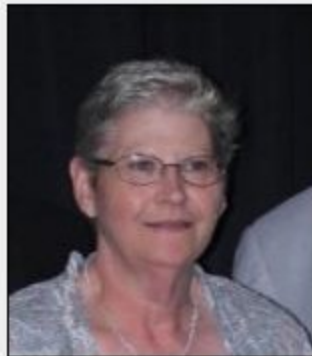


Debra J. Winger
